

# Explore Co-op and Internship Opportunities at Georgia Tech!

The Georgia Institute of Technology is a leader in technological research and education, and has been ranked by U.S. News and World Report as one of the top ten public universities in the nation for seven consecutive years. Georgia Tech awards the second largest number of bachelor's degrees in engineering in the United States, annually. But, Georgia Tech doesn't just graduate engineers — our students also major in architecture, computer science, management, liberal arts, sciences, and more!



## Undergraduate Co-op Program

— a paid, planned, progressive method of education rolled into a five-year academic program designed to complement your formal education with practical work experience directly related to your major. As a co-op, you'll alternate semesters of on-campus study with semesters of full-time employment from your freshman or sophomore year through your junior year, then continue in school through your senior year.

## Undergraduate Professional Internship (UPI) Program

— an academic program related to your major that will allow you to work at an employer location for at least one term. In many cases, you will have the opportunity to secure your own position and, after doing so, submit the job description and details to the UPI advisor for approval for UPI credit. As an intern in your junior or senior year, you'll typically work for a single semester but, in some situations, you may have the option of working for two consecutive terms.

## Graduate Co-op Program

— currently the largest graduate co-op program in the United States. The Graduate Co-op Program will provide you with the opportunity to work in any field of study offered at the Institute. In all cases, you'll work closely with your major school and industry and government leaders in your respective areas of study.

## Work Abroad Program

— a program that includes co-op, internship, graduate, and undergraduate work assignments outside the United States for juniors, seniors, and graduate students. These international work experiences will immerse you in practical training and cross-cultural exposure and learning, giving you the opportunity to acquire skills that will set you apart from your peers.
