Our flagship cooperative education program enables students to alternate classroom studies with full-time professional work. Co-op is fully integrated into the Northeastern curriculum, so academics and co-op inform and enhance each other.

NORTHEASTERN OFFERS STUDENTS:

- **Up to 18 months of full-time work experience** Our students complete up to three six-month, full-time co-ops. They work at nearly 2,000 employers around the world—like Deloitte, Disney, General Electric, Massachusetts General Hospital, Merrill Lynch, Microsoft, and the U.S. Government.
- **Co-op jobs in 65 majors** We offer co-op in 65 majors across six colleges—Arts and Sciences, Business Administration, Criminal Justice, Computer and Information Science, Engineering, and Health Sciences. A wide range of co-op jobs lets students explore a variety of fields and organizations; gain significant experience; and learn what you want to do.
- **People and tools to help you succeed** Every student works closely with a cooperative education adviser, who prepares you for co-op, helps you find jobs, and helps you reflect on and make the most of your experience.
